Early in his professional life, he was researcher and press secretary for a U.S. Congressman, where he worked on consumer protection legislation. When that company was sold in 1991, he opened his own consulting firm, Career Strategies Group, specializing in job search and re-careering for attorneys and executives in mid-life and beyond. When Bruce and his family moved to Cape Cod, he accepted the position of Executive Director of the Barnstable County Bar Association, where he helped modernize its technology and member services. A strong believer in consumer advocacy, Bruce resigned from the Bar Association to take over the helm of the CAC and increase its visibility and outreach services.
